

Full-time Contract Registered Nurse (6 Month Contract)

Position Overview: Operating within their full scope of practice, the RN will focus on palliative care initiatives and supporting, monitoring patients enrolled in our covid@home program. By assessing, monitoring, triaging and providing up to date covid-19 education to patients to determine symptom presence and severity of symptoms.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provides services to patients within full scope of practice of a registered nurse by assessing patients complete health care needs (physical, emotional, psychological, mental);
- Delivers up to date health education and other activities that assist, promote and support patients or communities as they strive to achieve the highest possible level of health;
- Follow patients' cases to observe progress and condition; provide counseling; and consult with nursing staff, physicians and other medical personnel as necessary.
- Observes and records vital and biometric measurements as well as outcomes;
- Triage patients according to acuity;
- Monitoring patients remotely using a secure web based solution
- Executes Physicians orders accordingly;
- Performs and supports various clinical procedures including covid-19 testing and vaccinations;
- Partners and works collaboratively with a multi-disciplinary team;
- Maintains accurate, concise and confidential EMR documentation;
- Ensures immunizations and vaccine inventory is current, monitored and ordered regularly;
- Ensures adequate supplies and equipment are available for daily patient care and emergency situations;
- Other duties as assigned.

KEY QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor of Science Degree in a primary care environment;
- Current certificate of Registration from the Ontario College of Nurses;
- Excellent patient assessment and triaging skills;
- A minimum of 1 year working experience in a primary care setting;
- Covid-19 response experience an asset
- CPR certification required.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, including facilitation skills;
- Intermediate knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel and EMR (e.g. Accuro);
- Able to work flexible hours in order to meet patient and physician needs which may include evenings.
